## **Instructions for Providing Tax Documentation**

Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) on the FAFSA:

- 1. Go to studentaid.gov
- 2. Log in to your 2023-24 FAFSA
- 3. Select "Make FAFSA Corrections"
- 4. Navigate to the Financial Information section (for both the student and parent, if applicable)
- 5. Answer a few questions and then click "Proceed to the IRS" to transfer 2021 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA.
- 6. Successfully transferring your tax information using the IRS DRT returns you to your FAFSA.
- 7. You must re-sign the FAFSA and submit the updated information.

**Please Note:** If you are providing a copy of a 2021 Federal Tax Return it must be <u>signed</u>. If you filed an amended return in 2021, you also need to submit a <u>signed</u> copy of your IRS Form 1040X.

## If you are unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool

Some students and parents may be unable to use the IRS DRT. Examples of these situations include: (1) Your marital status changed after December 31, 2021, (2) You filed your tax return as "married filing separately" and indicated a status of "married/re-married" when completing the FAFSA, and (3) You filed a foreign tax return.

If you are unable to use the IRS DRT, you can submit a <u>signed</u> copy of your 2021 tax return. If you did not keep a copy of your tax return, here are some options. Please note that due to COVID-19 restrictions, not all options may be available in your area.

- Access the tax software product you used to prepare and file your 2021 return. You may be able to access your account to download/print a copy.
- Contact the tax preparer/provider who filed your 2021 return if you used a tax professional.
- Access your tax transcript (a summary) at irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript.
  - o Click "Get Transcript Online" to register, then print or download your transcript immediately.
  - Click "Get Transcript by MAIL" to receive your transcript in 5 to 10 calendar days.
- Call the automated line at 800-908-9946 to order a transcript by mail.
- Submit a Form 4506-T, Request for Transcript of Tax Return, to the IRS via fax or mail to order a transcript to be mailed to you. Allow at least 2-4 weeks for delivery.
- You may be able to go directly to your local IRS office for an in-person request. You must call to make an appointment to obtain a transcript in person. To find a listing of IRS offices in your area, go to: http://www.irs.gov/uac/Contact-Your-Local-IRS-Office-1.

If you did not file a 2021 Tax Return, you will need to submit a 2021 IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter (dated 10/1/22 or after).
